Frequently Asked Questions

- Are there street closures?
 - Yes, Mill Street will be closed between Granville and Walnut Street from 9:00am-7:00pm.
- Where can I find up to date information?

- Are local businesses open during the festival?
 - Please check with each individual business, but yes, many are open during the festival.
- What time does the Festival begin?
 - Creepside runs from 1:00-5:00pm at Creekside Park
- Where can I park?
 - No parking 10/22/16; 9am-7pm: Mill Street Closed, Shull Ave., Carpenter St., Town St. to N. High,
 - Free Parking Available: Garage on Mill Street, Friendship Park, Gahanna Golf Course, Memorial Park, Gahanna Swim Club, Public lot near Sanctuary, Town St. (East of High), High Street, Jefferson Elementary
 - No Parking signs can be requested for pick up at City Hall at no charge to Gahanna residents or businesses, contact Zac Guthrie, 614-342-4268, to make arrangements.
- Should we come in costume?
 - Yes! Costumes are strongly encouraged at the Creepside Festival!
 - Adults are not permitted to wear masks or costumes that cover the face or head.
- Is there a cost associated with the event?
 - No, festival admittance is FREE! The paddleboat rides are \$5 per boat (for ½ hour)
- Are there food vendors?
 - Yes, there will be a variety of food vendors available during the event including current Creekside and Olde Gahanna Restaurants.
