

Memorial Tree Program

Trees are valuable resources and help communities in many ways. They create an aesthetically pleasing environment, provide oxygen, help clean the air of pollutants and odor, fight the greenhouse effect, and conserve energy by shading and cooling homes and buildings. They also help prevent water run-off and soil erosion, produce food and mulch, provide canopy and habitat for wildlife and help keep the atmosphere in balance. Trees can increase property values and produce a sense of community.



Donating to the Memorial Tree Program, you can help beautify our city parks while at the same time celebrate life by planting a tree! People often wish to leave living memorials for those they have lost or to celebrate the birth of a child, a wedding, or an anniversary. In response to these wishes, the Gahanna Department of Parks & Recreation has established this special program to allow people to donate towards planting trees on Gahanna Park land.

A donation of \$900 will plant a tree that will beautify our community for future generations to enjoy.

The trees are planted on City of Gahanna park land in the spring and fall seasons. The size and species of the trees planted will be appropriate to the site and will be at the discretion of the Parks staff. The Parks Superintendent and/or City Forester will work with donors on the location of the tree.

Creekside Park is not available for new memorial trees. The trees are the property of the City of Gahanna Parks and Recreation Department (GPRD).
